

KERITH CLIMATE & ENVIRONMENTAL DECLARATION

The leadership of Kerith Community Church publicly declare a climate and environmental emergency that requires urgent prayer and action.

We commit to respond to the facts

We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. *Romans 8:22*

The climate crisis is caused by human actions. Urgent behavioural change is necessary to limit global temperature increases to 1.5 degrees Celsius by 2030 to avoid further irreversible environmental, economic, and societal impacts.

Hosea 4:1-3

There is no faithfulness, no love, no acknowledgment of God in the land. There is only cursing, lying and murder, stealing and adultery; they break all bounds, and bloodshed follows bloodshed. Because of this the land mourns, and all who live in it waste away; the beasts of the field and the birds of the air and the fish of the sea are dying.

The climate crisis is unequivocally linked to global injustice, inequality and poverty.

Psalms 24:5-6

The earth is defiled by its people; they have disobeyed the laws, violated the statutes and broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore, a curse consumes the earth; its people must bear their guilt. Therefore, earth's inhabitants are burned up, and very few are left.
